Previous action items highlighted in yellow. New action items in red.

- Entrance signs Bids received. Total cost for one full sized sign on 156th and Reynolds (to match the one on State Street) and 2 smaller pillar signs on median on HWS Cleveland between Potter and Craig (southwest of PC Elementary; division between PC and Highland Hills) and 165th & State (division between PC and Summerhill Farm) will cost about the same as the existing one on State Street that was installed ~7 years ago. There will be an additional cost for site prep and lighting. We will need to purchase insurance for the signs. Corey will check into insurance cost. Kelsea will follow up on requested drawings, which we will present at the annual meeting.
 - Full sized sign: <\$20,000
 - Pillar signs: ~\$8,000 without kickout; ~\$10,000 with kickout
 - Site prep/electrical for all 3 sites: \$7,000
- Next year's budget will budget for another full-sized entrance sign for 156th and Potter.
- Annual dues the Board voted unanimously to keep dues at the current rate of \$94/year.
- 4. Fireworks for 2023 Date set: Saturday, July 1, 2023. We have already received a request from Pomodoro food truck to be booked for next year due to the success they had. Kelsea has been unable to get a response from Midwest Fireworks since the company was sold following our 2022 event. Annette will contact Bennington High School for info re: who they used for homecoming.
- PJ Morgan We have a growing list of outstanding business with Billy. He was scheduled to attend tonight's meeting virtually but no-showed. Michelle will draft an email to Billy and Cara outlining the following:
 - Still waiting on a copy of the state statutes in lay terms from PJM lawyers
 - Inconsistent answers regarding filing of our taxes
 - Incorrect information about our HOA on PJ Morgan's website still has not been corrected
 - How is he keeping track of new registrants from the website are they getting into AppFolio?
 - Letters providing notice of annual meeting still have not gone out, and this needs to happen ASAP.

- 6. Additional items for PJ Morgan:
 - Michelle will draft a proxy vote form like the one the Villas uses. We will request that this form be mailed out with the annual meeting notice letter.
 - We need an electronic survey to be sent out to homeowners to gauge interest in us pursuing covenant changes due to the time and cost involved. Michelle drafted a survey, which the Board reviewed at the meeting. Michelle will include this in the email to PJM.
